START CANDIDACY STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE

Every year, around early April, all Odisee students receive an email from the Student Council inviting them to apply as Student Representatives or Campus Chairs. Through the link provided in that email, you can apply yourself as a Stuver for your program. It's advisable to also write a motivational text along with your application. This text will need to convince all other students in your program to vote for you!

The voting round starts at the end of April! All Odisee students can then vote for the Student Representative of their program and the Campus President of their campus. During this phase, you can also campaign yourself to convince others to vote for you.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

After the voting round, the results will be announced for each program and campus.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY (GA)

To conclude the elections, the Student Council organizes a General Assembly (GA) every year, during which the new board is elected for the upcoming academic year. After the assembly, there is always a large networking moment with complimentary food, drinks, speeches, photos, and more.
